

- 2. Remove the brackets from the frame.
- 3. Install the sub saddle bag pipe on the holders of the frame.



- 3. Temporarily install the right saddle bag pipe.
- 4. Temporarily install the left saddle bag pipe.



- 5. Tighten all bolts and nuts to the specified torques.
- 6. Reinstall the seat.

5 USE AND CARE

- Do not use the saddle bag pipes to carry other accessories or cargos.
- Do not attach tie-downs or ropes to the saddle bag pipes when transporting the motorcycle on a trailer or truck bed.
- Be extremely careful not to damage the motorcycle and other accessories with the saddle bag pipes when installing them.
- Handle the saddle bag pipes with care. They are cosmetic parts and are not designed to protect the saddle bags.
- Check the saddle bag pipes for security from time to time and retighten them if necessary.
- Be sure to check the motocycle and accessories for damage and replace all damaged parts with new ones when the motocycle tipped over.
